

# Call for applications for the Summer School on SPORT AND ATHLETICS IN ANCIENT GREECE AND SPARTA

The University of Rome Unitelma Sapienza, together with the Institute of Sparta and the University of the Peloponnese, is now accepting applications for the "Summer School on Sport and Athletics in ancient Greece and Sparta".

The Summer School will be organized in presence at the main campus of the University of Peloponnese (Sparta, Greece). It will include theoretical lectures, practical workshops, visits to the main archaeological sites and museums of ancient Sparta and the sanctuary of Zeus at Olympia and the participation in the 4th International Conference on Ancient Sparta.

#### Course description

The Summer School will take place from the 2<sup>nd</sup> to the 11<sup>th</sup> of September 2024 at the University of the Peloponnese (Sparta). The classes will be held in English by professors from UniteIma Sapienza & Sapienza University, University of the Peloponnese and expert lecturers from all over the world.

The call is addressed to undergraduate and postgraduate students in the field of archaeology, PhD candidates, as well as researchers and scholars of any age.

## Program description

The Summer School will focus on topics related to the importance of sports in Spartan society, culture and religion.

The lessons will be supported by guided tours in the main archaeological sites and museums, according to a scheduled program that will be subsequently send via email to the participants.

Upon completion, the participants will receive a certificate of attendance.



#### Fees and Facilitation

No fees are requested to participate to the Summer School. Participants are responsible for their own travel, visa, meals, and accommodation fees. Upon request, the University can provide accommodation suggestions.
